Dear President Kessler and Speaker Thompson:

After the submission of my recommended FY 2014 Executive Budget on February 13, 2013, there have been a few areas that require adjustments and, therefore, I would like to provide you with additional recommended revisions to the TITLE II - APPROPRIATIONS:

Section 1. Appropriations from general revenue.

Judicial

Supreme Court - General Judicial, Fund 0180, Fiscal Year 2014, Org 2400

(To reflect revised request.)

- Decrease "Current Expenses" Activity 130 by \$4,000,000.

Department of Commerce

Division of Forestry, Fund 0250, Fiscal Year 2014, Org 0305

(To maintain operations at the Clements State Tree Nursery.)

- Increase "Personal Services" Activity 001 by \$160,000.
- Increase "Employee Benefits" Activity 010 by \$65,000.
- Increase "Current Expenses" Activity 130 by \$140,000.
- Increase "Repairs and Alterations" Activity 064 by \$15,000.
